- **Check in begins at 5:30 pm** in the front parking lot of the WISD 9th Grade Center, 1007 S Main St. This is necessary to receive a number for line-up purposes and judging/announcing.
- Parade line-up is at 5:30 pm sharp and the Parade will start at 6:30 pm.
- Entries must follow the entire parade (long parade route) starting at the NGC, turning right onto S Main, around the court house, then west on Hwy 180, left on Alamo St, ending at Cherry Park.
- The visuals and music must be appropriate for family audiences.
- Nothing can be thrown or handed out from the entry. This includes candy.
- Adults / Parents or guardians must accompany/supervise all minors.
- Clean up service will be provided by this organization for equine entries.
